



How to Apply:

1. Complete the [Imua Preschool Application](#).
2. Submit \$20 non-refundable application fee via check, cash or credit card
3. The Program Assistant or Director will contact you within 7 days of receiving your application to inform you of availability. Your name will be placed on our waitlist. If spaces are available, the following next steps will be scheduled (must be completed by all families for final consideration):

- a. Classroom visit

The classroom visit is an opportunity for preschool staff to observe your child in a group setting without you for up to an hour. The staff understands that your child may respond adversely. Should any child be upset at any moment during the visit, you will be asked to come and join them in the classroom for the remainder of the hour. The classroom visit may include inside time, circle time and snack time. You are welcome to stay a little longer and join your child on the playground.

- b. Developmental screening

The developmental screening is conducted by our occupational therapist. The current tool is the Batelle Developmental Inventory which takes approximately 45 min to complete. This screening tool includes parent report questions as well as observable criteria. The results of the screener will be shared with you by the therapist within 7 days of completion. If your child's scores indicate any red flags, the therapist will guide you in determining the next step.

4. Notification of Program Acceptance: When all potential applicants for available spaces have completed a. and b., you will be notified of acceptance or denial via mail. If you choose to accept an offered space, you must call and speak with the Program Assistant or Director within 3 days of receiving your notice.
